Job Description

CASTL seeks a highly motivated individual who can joyfully and energetically take on the varied administrative duties of a newer school. Familiarity with Google Workspace and Rediker is preferred, but not required.

Daily Office Administration

- Manage day-to-day front office operations including:
- Student attendance
- Collecting and sending out mail
